- Present in 5 continents and 25 countries
- **Prof. Bernard Foing** is the President, elected July 15° 2021, during the 3° World Congress
- **Adriano V. Autino** is the founder, President up to July 2021, Strategy Director
- The organization has three main directive organs: the President, the Board of Directors, the Executive Secretariat
- A large Board of Advisors contributes to the SRI global strategy
- The head of ESA, Dr. Jan Wörner, astronaut Paolo Nespoli, and others, are honorary members

The Medici Fund Programme



The Medici Fund Programme

- The goal: to support the renaissance of our civilization in space, namely, the science, philosophy and art, and the enabling technology for the civilian space development.
- Named after the Renaissance Italy family who were renowned for their generosity of funding for the arts and sciences. As a non-profit grant making body (equivalent to the US 501(c)(3) Private Operating Foundation) SRI operates the Medici Fund Programme.

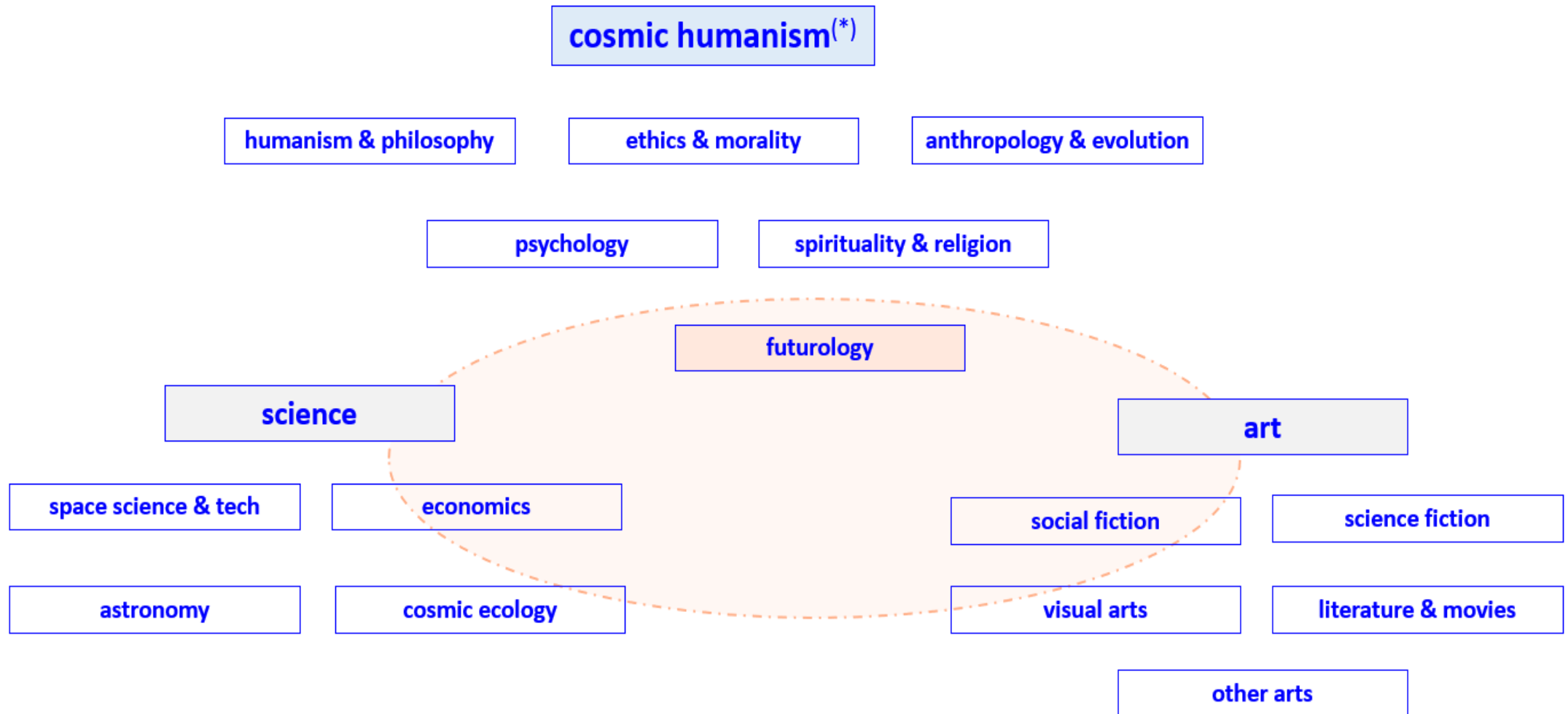
The SR Academy Mentorship Programme

- The Mentorship Programme is made by two main parts:
 - **Students** have the possibility to [choose their favorite themes](#) for graduation theses or Ph.D works.
 - **Mentors** have the possibility to [choose their favorite disciplines](#), on which they like to provide mentorship to students.
 - The SR Academy will take care of creating the link among students and mentors, for the different themes / disciplines.
 - We will also contact Universities, in order to coordinate this beautiful effort.
- Why did Space Renaissance engage in this adventure?
 - **First: focus.** Our proposed themes and disciplines are not generic themes related to space.
 - All of our proposals are related to our main mission: to support and favor the expansion of civilization into the outer space.
 - Some key scientific and technological research strands do not have the proper priority.
 - Our initiative aims to raise awareness on such topics, in the academic world and among the students, encouraging them to engage in the greatest work of all times: making humanity a space faring civilization.
 - **Another key rationale: to help the young generations** to choose their place in the world and their road to the stars.
 - **A priority aim: to increase the visibility and possibility to help of many space supporters** endowed by educational capabilities.
 - They are bearer of great concepts, and can be key to inject enthusiasm and hope in many young students, helping them to come up from the existential situation of the closed world.
 - **Last, but not least: not only science!** We also want to work with philosophy, literature, art and the humanistic disciplines. The first obstacle to civilian space development is not scientific nor technological nor economic: it is philosophic and politic!

The Civilian Space Protocol (CSP) Initiative

All Governments of Planet Earth are strongly recommended

1. To give priority to the following strands of research, all of which are essential to allow the transport, accommodation, and prolonged stay of people in space: low-cost space transport systems for civilian goods and passengers, low acceleration spacecrafts (both at launch and re-entry), safe and comfortable atmospheric reentry mechanisms, protection from cosmic radiation, lunar habitats, orbital habitats endowed with artificial gravity by rotation, artificial green ecosystems in closed environments.
2. To facilitate the creation of an international coordination for the New Space sector, which will bring the space industries together with universities, research institutes and space agencies.
3. To define and adopt national laws for the removal and reuse of existing space scrap and debris, and the prevention of the creation of new debris, everywhere.
4. To support the sharing, by leading industries in the New Space sector, of the best practices for the creation of virtuous supply chains, including the development and maintenance of a database of the New Space companies and resources worldwide.
5. Mentoring by institutions for the allocation of regional, national and international funds to support the civilian space projects.
6. Developing a friendly policy towards New Space companies, through incentives to raise their competitiveness, leading to the hiring of both young graduates and experienced personnel.
7. Promoting the creation of Space Investment Funds, designed to support the development of the New Space industry.
8. To relocate at least 20% of the military expense to support the civilian space development.
