## OUR POSITIONS:

- Developing an international framework that will support private activity while protecting essential public policies
- Nations should engage with private sector in development of framework, include in any new processes/institutions
- Supporting the Working Group on Legal Aspects of Space Resource Activity, and the Action Team on Lunar Activity Consultation (ATLAC)
- The Outer Space Treaty should be basis of any new legal framework for outer space activity
- Supporting the private sector in outer space is good public policy - We need its resources, talent, creativity, diversity, enthusiasm

## CLARIFYING AMBIGUITIES IN THE OUTER SPACE TREATY:

1. Ownership of resources removed from “in place”
  - Confirm not “appropriation” under OST Article II
  - Confirm status of national laws that authorize private ownership
2. Jurisdiction and control of stations, installations, facilities (OST Art. XII. MA Art. 12)
3. Share Information as much as possible, but confirm protection of intellectual property rights under national laws (COPUOS LTS Guideline 1.19)
4. Clarify due regard, avoidance of harmful interference and contamination
  - Require environmental impact assessments of space resource activity
  - Protect both present interests and future interests

SRI proposes to the **ARTEMIS Accords** and the **International Lunar Research Station (ILRS)** to plant a **United Nations flag on the Moon**, as a powerful symbol of **global unity, peace, and sustainable space governance**, transcending national boundaries. SRI and the **18th SDG Coalition**, emphasize that space development should serve all humanity, supporting equality, cooperation, and shared benefits. We refer to Frank White's **Overview Effect**, which inspired astronauts to see Earth as interconnected and without borders. This proposal also resonates with the history of collaboration, friendship, equitable partnership and mutual respect in space, from Apollo-Soyuz, to Mir, and the International Space Station (ISS). Planting the U.N. flag would set a precedent for peaceful extraterrestrial activities, advocating for a **weapons-free and non-militarized outer space**. The initiative also calls for recognizing **sustainable civilian space development** as a key SDG to help solve global challenges like **poverty, inequality, and environmental degradation**. Ultimately, the U.N. flag on the Moon would stand for a future guided by **humanity's shared ideals and mutual respect**, fostering inclusive participation in space and ensuring its benefits reach all people.
